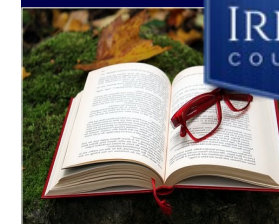

**Most vaccines are offered without a physician's order*

State laws require children to be vaccinated against up to ten infectious diseases before attending daycare or school. These immunizations help protect your children from serious illnesses.

Our goal is to prevent childhood and adult diseases in our community. We provide all required school and travel vaccines in our clinic. We encourage all infants, children and adults to receive most recommended vaccines by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for best protection.

- Be honest with your child. Explain that shots can pinch or sting, but that it won't hurt for long.
- Avoid telling scary stories or making threats about shots.
- Remind children that vaccines will keep them healthy.

SHOT INFO

For Pre-K to 12th Grade

2017-2018 Child Required Vaccines by Age

Pre-K :

- (4) DTaP
- (3) Polio
- (3 or 4) Hib or (1) Hib after 15 mo.
- (2) MMR *after 12 mo.
- (3) Hepatitis B *last after 12 mo.
- (4) Pneumococcal *before 15 mo.
- (1) Varicella

Grade K-2 : *HIB not required after age 5

- (4 or 5) DTP/DTap *last after 4 yrs.
- (3 or 4) Polio *last after 4 yrs.
- (2) MMR *first dose on or after 12 mo.
- (3) Hepatitis B *last after 6 mo.
- (2) Varicella *first dose on or after 12 mo.

Grades 3-5 : *HIB not required after age 5

- (4 or 5) DTP/DTap *last after 4 yrs.
- (4) Polio *last after 4 yrs.
- (2) MMR *first dose on or after 12 mo.
- (3) Hepatitis B *last after 6 mo.
- (2) Varicella *first dose on or after 12 mo.

Grades 6-12 :

- (4 or 5) DTP/DTap *last after 4 yrs.
- (1) Tdap *booster for those entering grade 7
- (4) Polio *last after 4 yrs.
- (2) Measles *first dose on or after 12 mo.
- (3) Hepatitis B *last after 6 mo.
- (1) Varicella *first dose on or after 12 mo.
- (1) MCV * 1 dose for entering grade 7
